Outside: The 1214 m2 block of land has a gentle slope, good soil for gardening, two carports (one with a garden/tool shed), large shade trees, numerous cottage style gardens and an abundance of varied established fruit trees.

Location: Short walk to Narira Creek (at the bottom of the street), swimming pool, main shopping area, Cobargo Hotel, sporting fields, showground and primary school. A twenty minute drive south takes you to Bega, or head east to Bermagui and its pristine beaches, amazing mountain views, boat ramps and many fine eating venues.

Cobargo is a small town with a great friendly community. Markets are held each Saturday in the main street which attracts a lot of visitors and has the The Cobargo Folk Festival in May each year bringing performers together from all over the country.
